VAL'S GARDENING PROGRAM Hi everyone. It's great to drive around Echuca Moama and see all the beautiful magnolias that are blooming at the moment. Blossom trees, wattles,

jonquils and daffodils are also flowering. Plants and trees are coming out of their winter hibernation with the promise that spring is just around the corner.

Have you got all your pruning done? Weeds are always a problem, but now's a good time to pull them out while the earth is damp from the recent rain. Now is also the time to plant flowers for the butterflies and lettuces for your salad bowl.

With vegetables being so dear in the shops maybe it's time to freshen up your veggie patch. The kids can help you. Once the frosts have stopped you can plant celery, silverbeet, lettuce, leeks, spring onions, climbing beans, cucumber, sweet corn, tomato, carrot, Jerusalem artichoke and radishes. 
LAST PROGRAM & OLD ANTENNA REMOVAL
