They were accompanied by teacher Peter Fawcett and support staff, Narelle Pigatto and Kasey Cooper.




#### **OUTSIDE BROADCASTS - LOCKINGTON SWAP MEET & SHOW 'N'SHINE 19/05/24**


together for your listening pleasure and as a presenter, appreciate and value your feedback - it means a lot and please keep your requests coming my way. Kind regards, Val Horne.
