GRANTS: As you know EMFM is a not-for-profit organisation and we exist through sponsorship announcements, membership fees and grants. Over the years we have been very lucky to receive grants to help provide the things we need to keep broadcasting. We receive grants from different organisations - CBF, FRRR, EMCE, Moama RSL, Workers - but I'd particularly like to thank the Campaspe Shire. We have just received funding through their Community Grants Program to purchase a small 3m x 3m marquee which will be easily erected by one or two people, and can be used when our large one won't fit the space allocated. Thank you to all the organisations who provide grants to help non for profit groups to continue their work.

OUR NEWEST PRESENTER - BRUCE CHAPMAN



Born in the 60's I grew up listening to everything that moved. I was very fortunate to be trained in Ballarat at a very young age as a drummer by Don Kerby and played my first professional gig at 13 years old. For 10 years

I played in country rock and cabaret bands covering every type of venue you could imagine.

I learnt the business from the live shows, watching great bands like Trevor Gleeson and Chiodo, The Blue Echoes and of course Countdown.

I became a rock and roll crank when Ol'55 hit the scene and also studied Happy Days on TV. Learning to sing and to harmonise at a young age led me to create the very successful 50's band, The Teddy Boys, and I was the front man.

Retiring from the music scene I moved to Echuca 10 years ago and I was introduced to Radio EMFM and now enjoy presenting that specific time of the past sound and talking about different artists throughout the show.
